- To qualify for the *Max Yield* Rebate, the application of Fortalis® in a tank-mix with the grower's preferred strobilurin/triazole fungicide must be supported by application information provided to the grower's local retailer that includes the amount of Fortalis® used and the name and amount of fungicide used.
- *Max Yield* Rebate payments will be based on the grower submitting a completed *Max Yield* Survey located at www.FortalisYields.com/max-yield or by post to Plant Impact, Inc. at 3005 Carrington Mill Boulevard, Morrisville, NC 27560 before November 1, 2017.
- Combination foliar fungicides labeled for use on soybeans have more than one mode-of-action and include **Approach® Prima**, **Avaris®**, **Fortix®**, **Preemptor®**, **Priaxor®**, **Priaxor® D**, **Quadris Top® SB**, **Quadris Top SBX®**, **Stratego® YLD**, and others.
- Eligible rebates will be paid by December 15, 2017.
